Dale H. Boyd, Sr., 76, of Albany, died Tuesday, December 9, 2008 at his residence. The funeral service will be held at 11 AM Saturday at Crown Hill Cemetery with military honors. The Rev. Andy Goode will officiate. A native of Old Stoneington, IL, Mr. Boyd had lived in Albany for many years. He retired from the United States Marine Corps in the early '70's. Mr. Boyd then went to work with the civil service here in Albany at the Marine Corps Logistics Base until his retirement in 1984. He was a veteran of the Korean War and the Vietnam Conflict. Mr. Boyd loved to read and travel. He was preceded in death by his loving wife of forty years, Jean Boyd and a brother, James Boyd. Mr. Boyd is survived by his children: Stephanie L.
