Charles David Goff, 48, of Sylvester, GA, died Thursday, March 8, 2012 at the Willson Hospice House following an illness.

His memorial service will be Sunday, March 11, 2012 at 2 PM at Pine Bluff Baptist Church. The Rev. Keith Smith and the Rev. Terrell Roberts will officiate. His remains will be cremated and will interment will take place following the memorial service in Spring Hill Primitive Baptist Church Cemetery in Irwin County. The family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern on Saturday from 4-6 PM.

Mr. Goff was born in Atlanta, GA and was a 1981 graduate of Albany High School. He attended ABAC and Albany Technical College. Mr. Goff was a member of Pine Bluff Baptist Church. He worked for Queen Carpet in Tifton, GA, and then with Cooper Tire. He was an enthusiastic University of Georgia Bulldog fan as well an avid NASCAR fan, driving in the Richard Petty Experience at the Atlanta Motor Speedway. Mr. Goff was devoted to his family and enjoyed spending time with them and his friends. David Goff fought a 5 year battle with Glioblastoma multiform stage 4 brain cancer.
