David S. Orgel, 82, of Albany, died Friday, November 4, 2016 at the Willson Hospice House.

His funeral service will be at 11 AM on Tuesday, November 8, 2016 at Morningside United Methodist Church with interment to follow at Riverside Cemetery. The Rev. Anna Miller will officiate. The family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern on Monday, November 7, 2016 from 6-8 PM.

David Orgel was born in St. Louis, MO, and lived most of his life in Albany. He graduated from Albany High School in 1953. He attended ABAC and South Georgia College, and he graduated from the University of Georgia in 1960. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army. Mr. Orgel raised homing pigeons and he was a member of the Albany Homing Pigeon Club. He worked at Bennett Supply for over 30 years where he was affectionately known as the “chicken man.” David Orgel had a joke for everyone, whether he saw you at work, in a restaurant, or around town. He was preceded in death by his parents, Samuel Z. Orgel and Sara S. Orgel.
