Deana Brown Warren, age 67, died Friday July 6, 2007 in Atlanta, GA, from complications related to Alzheimer's Disease. She was a long time resident of Albany and graduated from Albany High School. Ms Warren was an accomplished musician, and played piano and organ as a young woman, at East Albany Baptist Church, where her parents were charter members. Ms Warren moved to Atlanta some 25 years ago while working with Dr William Harris, founder of Practice Consultants, a chiropractic practice consulting organization. She was also instrumental in assisting Dr. Harris in the establishment of the Foundation for the Advancement of Chiropractic Education. She was a keynote speaker and training advisor for several years. Ms Warren is survived by a son, Christopher C. Warren and wife Catherine Nguyen Warren of Tustin, CA, and a daughter Mary Warren Livings of Thomasville, GA.
