Dewey Heath, Jr., died Thursday, May 17, 2007 at his residence. The funeral service will be held at 11 AM Tuesday, May 22, 2007 at Lakeside Baptist Church with interment to follow in Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. Ken Chancellor will officiate. A native of Alabama, Mr. Heath had lived in Albany since 1971. He was a member of Lakeside Baptist Church, the Adult Men's Sunday School Class, and the Choir. Mr. Heath retired after 20 years of service from the United States Air Force where he served during the Korean Conflict and the Vietnam War. He also retired from the City of Albany Police Department after 21 years of service. Mr. Heath is survived by his loving wife Mary "Liz" Heath of Putney; a son, Gary Heath; a daughter, Lisa Heath both of Newnan; 3 grandchildren, Michael, Randy, and Jason Heath; four great-grandchildren; 2 step-daughters, Rose Marie Carey of Fredericksburg, VA, and Michelle Blalock of Leesburg; a step-son, Ralph Justice, Jr. of Worth County; and 4 step-grandchildren, Anthony Carey, Devon Carey, Sierra Justice, and Madison Justice.
