Dolly "Mimi" Campbell Hayman, 95, of Albany, died Thursday, December 21, 2006 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital. The funeral service will be held 11 AM Saturday, December 23, 2006 at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors with Rev. Joe Lumpkin and Dr. William Sims, III officiating. Entombment will follow at Crown Hill Mausoleum. A native of Jacksonville, FL, Mrs. Hayman had lived in Albany since 1938 and attended Sherwood Baptist Church and Gillionville Baptist Church.
