Don Funderburke, 75, of Kennesaw, GA, died Sunday, May 24, 2026 at Wellstar Hospice in Marietta, GA after a short but brave fight against cancer.

His funeral service will be at 2 PM on Monday, June 1, 2026 at the graveside at Crown Hill Cemetery in Albany, GA with a celebration of life to follow in the Kennesaw area at a later date.

Mr. Funderburke was born on August 25 in Albany, GA. He graduated from Dougherty County High School and was a member of Morningside Methodist.
