Mr. Don Williams, 79, of Americus died Monday Mar 30, 2015 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital.

His funeral service will be held Saturday 11:00AM at Sherwood Baptist Church. Rev. John Spencer will be officiating. Interment will follow 4:00PM at Patterson City Cemetery in Patterson, GA. The family will receive friends one hour before service at the Church.

Born in Vidalia, GA, Mr. Williams went to Berry College and then GA Teacher's College. He received his master's degree at the University of GA in mathematics. Mr. Williams taught High School in Thompson and Waycross, then collegiately at Wesleyan in Macon for thirteen years. Don and his wife Faye then moved to Albany in 1975 where they worked together selling World Book Encyclopedia. Mr. Williams returned to teaching at Monroe High School for two years before retiring from after many years of teaching at Albany State College.

Mr. Williams was a member of Sherwood Baptist Church and the Golden K Club. As an Avid Photographer he enjoyed photographing weddings and being the resident photographer at Wesleyan College.

He was preceded in death by his parents Haywood and Emma Dykes Williams and his wife Nola Faye Griner Williams.
