Donald Lee Bryan, Sr., 87 of Albany died Wednesday, September 20, 2017 at his residence. Funeral services will be held Saturday, September 23, 2017 at 2:00 PM at Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church. Visitation will follow after the service. Rev. Robert Green will officiate.

Born September 13, 1930 in St. Louis, MO, Donald graduated from high school in January of 1948. He married Bernice Patton on May 14, 1948, was employed by Hormel Foods for 38 years and was a charter member of Covenant Presbyterian Church. He was an elder in the church until he was transferred as a sales manager for Hormel to Montgomery, AL in 1971. They transferred from Montgomery, AL to Boston MA to be a manager for Hormel, then 2 years later, transferred to Virginia Beach, VA. After retirement from Hormel, they returned to Albany, GA. There he began Don Sales and after 10 years with Don Sales he retired again.

Mr. Bryan was a member of the Key Class at Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church in Albany. He was a proud member of the Exchange Club up until his death and was the Exchangite of the year in 1993. Don was also a member of the All Star Football Officials Association for 25 years. He also enjoyed being the scoreboard operator and announcer for Darton College baseball, high school baseball and American Legion baseball.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Paul Bryan and Mary Louise Bryan, a brother Kenneth Bryan and his sister Carolyn Aikens.
