Mr. Donald (Don) "Luckey" Barfield Luckey, 70, of 1904 Palmyra Road, died January 22, 2012 at the Palmyra Nursing Home due to a short battle with Leukemia.

Don Luckey was born October 9, 1941 in Crisp County, Georgia.
