



## Col. Donald R. Seay Obituary

March 8, 1933 - February 6, 2007

Col. Donald Roosevelt Seay, (USMC Retired), died Tuesday, February 6, 2007 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital. Col. Seay was born in Summerville, WV. He graduated from Fairmont State College in 1955 with a B. A. degree in Education, and from Central Michigan University in 1979 with a M.A. degree in Management and Supervision. Col. Seay retired after twenty-seven years of service in the United States Marine Corps where he served during Vietnam and was a member of the Retired Marine Officer's Association. Col. Seay was a Senior Computer System Analyst Consultant with ATAC from 1985 until 1987 and other computer services until 1991. He was also a property owner and landlord to Lafayette Plaza. Col. Seay was a member of Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church where he was also a member of the United Methodist Men's Fellowship Group. Col. Seay loved sports as he was a lover of basketball and was an avid golfer. Col. Seay was a member of Doublegate Country Club, GA Senior Golf Association and Stonebridge Golf and Country Club. Col. Seay is survived by his wife Joan Seay of Albany; a daughter, Jan Seay of Clarksville, IN; a son, Thomas Rodney Seay of Albany; a granddaughter, Tiffany Erin Seay of Albany; two sisters, Doris Donald and her husband of Petersburg, VA, and Daisy Crookshanks of Ronceverte, WV.
