Donna Harrington, 55, of Albany, died Tuesday, November 10, 2020, at Emory St Joseph Hospital.

Memorial services were held Saturday, November 14, 2020, at Moultrie Church of Christ in Moultrie, Ga. With Zach Griffin and Rev. John Harrington officiated.

Born May 8, 1965 in Dickson, Tennessee, she was the daughter of Ralph and Doris Cude of Moultrie, Georgia. Ms. Harrington was a Senior Accountant and Office Manager at Geer & Associates CPA PC for 20 years. Donna loved all types of arts and crafts and spent her spare time making potholders, plastic canvas, afghans for family and friends and as gifts. During football season she was always cheering on her beloved Troy Trojans and Tennessee Vols and never missed a Troy home game where she could meet up with past school mates. Ms Harrington loved traveling but what was most important to Donna was spending time with her family.
