



## Mrs. Doris Baker

December 23, 1935 - February 28, 2015

Doris Annette Baker, 79, of Albany, died Saturday, February 28, 2015. A memorial service will be held at 11 a.m., Saturday, March 7 at Edison Baptist Church in Edison, Georgia. The Rev. Keith Gaines will officiate. The family will receive friends at the church from 10 a.m. until the service begins. Born in Cairo, Georgia at the home of her grandparents to the Rev. and Mrs. James and Jewel Baker, she spent her younger years in the Cairo and Thomasville area. As an adult she lived for a time in Florida, California, Brunswick, Gordon, and Thomasville. She lived the last 8 ½ years in Albany. Until recent years when her eyesight and health worsened she was a quite prolific poet, writing personal poems to and for her loved ones and even had some published in her local newspapers. A homemaker, she also had worked as a secretary and a court reporter. She was a member of the Parkway Church of God in Thomasville and an active member of the Residents Council of PruittHealth–Palmyra nursing home where she was twice elected “Ms. Palmyra.”
