



Mrs. Doris Peek Horne Williams Obituary

Mrs. Doris Peek Horne Williams lived a full and vibrant life for over 92 years, leaving all that knew her a happier person for having had her in their lives. Doris passed away on October 23, 2011.

Doris was born in Atlanta, Georgia on March 12, 1919 to the late Hobson Dewey Peek and Mildred Frances Clay Peek. She spent the remainder of her life in the Albany area where she raised her three daughters. She retired from the Dougherty County Tax Office after 27 years on Loyal Service. Doris was deeply devoted to her church, First United Methodist Church of Albany, of which she was a lifetime member.
