Doris Knight Lorig, 94, of Albany, GA, died Friday, January 05, 2018 at the Willson Hospice House.

Her funeral service will be at 3:30 PM on Sunday (Today), January 7, 2018 at the graveside at Riverside Cemetery. The family will receive friends on Sunday prior to the service at Kimbrell-Stern from 2-3 PM. A memorial service will held at a later date.
