



## E. Marshall Munde Obituary

April 6, 1919 - March 12, 2005

Born in Jacksonville, Fla., Mr. Munde spent his early years in Wilmette, Ill., attending New Trier High School and Northwestern University prior to moving to Albany in 1952. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II, spending 32 months in the South Pacific with Company G, 186th Infantry, 41st Division. He participated in landings in Hollandia and Biak in New Guinea, receiving the Bronze Star. Mr. Munde's business career included owning and operating Munde Inc. Construction business and later serving managerial positions in the automotive and moving and storage businesses prior to retiring from Rhodes Heating and Cooling. A former member of the Dougherty County Kiwanis Club, he was active in the early years of Kiwanis sponsored Little League Baseball. He was a member of St. Teresa's Catholic Church. He was preceded in death by his parents, Ernest and Genevieve Munde, son, Joe Munde, and a brother, Joseph Donald Munde. He is survived by his wife, Polly, daughters, Anne Jones and husband Lynn of Ocala, Fla., Kay Nolan and husband Craig of Albertville, Ala., Jeanne Barton and husband James of Elmodel, Ginger Hakala and husband Michael of New Smyrna Beach, Fla., and sons Marsh Munde Jr., of Charlotte, N.C., and David Munde of Dothan, Ala., as well as grandchildren, David, Alan and Joseph Jones, Catherine, Christina, Patrick, Daniel and Caroline Nolan, Jennifer Munde, Jamie Barton and Maria Barton Rish.
