



## E. Clayton Powell, Jr. Obituary

A native of Cairo, GA, Mr. Powell had lived in Albany since 1930 before moving to Lake Blackshear in 1999 and was retired catalog manager from Sears. He was a member of First United Methodist Church, member and former Sunday School Teacher in the Fellowship Sunday School Class and a former member of the Administrative Board. After retiring from Sears, Clayton acquired his real estate license and worked with Walden and Kirkland Realtors until 1999. He was also a member of the Albany Board of Realtors, National Association of Realtor, and the Georgia Association of Realtors. Mr. Powell was a member of the Exchange Club of Albany and was selected Exchangite of the Year in 1976. He was also a charter member of the Shuttle Drivers for Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital and was a veteran of WW II having served in the US Navy. He was pre-ceded in death by his first wife Nell Holcomb Powell.
