



Edmund F. Haggerty, Sr. Obituary

May 21, 1926 - September 25, 2007

Edmund Francis Haggerty, Sr., 81, of Albany, died Tuesday, September 25, 2007 at Palmyra Medical Center following an illness. His funeral service will be FRIDAY 11 AM at St. Teresa's Catholic Church with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. Finbarr Stanton will officiate. A native of Arlington, MA, Mr. Haggerty had lived in Albany since 1957. He was a member of St. Teresa's Catholic Church. A Navy veteran of WWII, Mr. Haggerty was employed with the FBI for 26 years, retiring in 1976. Following his retirement from the FBI, he worked with Sun Trust Bank and with Gardner, Willis, Sweat, and Goldsmith for many years. He was also a member of the Society of Former FBI Agents, the Golden K Kiwanis Club, and the Knights of Columbus. Mr. Haggerty was very involved with many civic groups in Albany, and especially enjoyed working with Neighbors in Need and as a tutor with the Dougherty County School System. He was preceded in death by his wife Annette Gearty Haggerty, a sister, Anne Haggerty Austin, a brother Robert Haggerty, and his parents Edmond & Margaret Haggerty.
