Mr. Edmundo Cruz Ramos, 88, of Albany died Tuesday Aug 2, 2022 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital.

His funeral mass will be held Saturday 11:30AM at St. Teresa's Catholic Church with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. Rev. Ray Levreault will be officiating.

Born in the Philippines, Mr. Ramos was the second child of Cesario Ramos and Andrea Cruz Ramos. He attended Elementary, High School, Pre-Law in the Philippines and Albany Vocational College in Albany, GA. He married his first wife Cheryl Pate in 1963, then his second wife Marianne Hostetter from 1964-1969 with two kids Mike and Susie, third wife Bobbie Ann Washington 1970-1987 with two kids Ydee Vohn and Kevin and his fourth wife Helen D.P. Ramos 1998 till present and their child Maria Yvonne Ramos.

He worked as a Hospital Orderly and American Hospital, an Investment Councilor with Mutual Funds. Mr. Ramos was a Life insurance assistant manager with Mutual Life, District Sales Construction Material Superior Product Collector Bldg. Material. He served in the U.S Navy during the Vietnam conflict. Mr. Ramos worked at Proctor and Gamble and retired from the Marine Corp. Logistics Base in Albany. He also worked Dyncor Productions.

Mr. Ramos was a member of St. Teresa's Catholic Church, Knights of Columbus, The American Legion and the DAV.

Besides his parents he was preceded in death by his siblings Louder, Lucila,
