Edward M. Childree Sr., of Albany died Wednesday, September 20, 2006 at his residence. His funeral service will be 2 PM Saturday, September 23, 2006 at Sherwood Baptist Church. A native of Taylor County, Mr. Childree came to Albany upon retiring from the United States Air Force with 23 years of service. He served his country proudly during WWII, seeing duty in the European Theatre. He was a member of the Military Officers Association of America and a 45 year member of Sherwood Baptist Church. He was a Life Deacon, Sunday school teacher and a member of the Baptist Builders and Baptist on Missions, helping build churches. He was preceded in death by his parents Jeffie Windham and William Jennings Childree; a son-in-law Larry Harrell and 2 brothers Hugh and Cecil Childree.
