Edward Max Fink, 58, died unexpectedly Saturday, September 30, 2006 in Albany. Funeral services will be TUESDAY, October 3, 2006 at 11 AM at Kimbrell-Stern with Rabbi Dana E. Kaplan officiating. Interment services will follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. Born April 30, 1948 in New York, Ed Fink lived in Albany for 55 years. He was the son of the late Laurence Irving Fink and the late Ila Gross Fink. A 1966 graduate of Albany High School and a 1971 graduate of the University of Georgia, he was a member of Phi Epsilon Pi social fraternity. He was employed by Shiver Computers for nineteen years. A member of Temple B'Nai Israel, Ed served as treasurer on the Board of Trustees. He was a member of the Temple Brotherhood and Stonebridge Country Club. Mr. Fink is survived by his wife of 35 years: Janie Smith Fink, Albany; their three children: Leslie Fink, Columbus, Ashley Shapiro and her husband Micah, Valdosta, GA, Adam Fink and his wife Huntley, Albany; two grandchildren: Evan Fink, Albany, and Madison Shapiro, Valdosta. He also leaves a sister: Beverly "Cookie" Sloat, West Hartford, CT; a brother: Stephen Fink, Albany; sixteen nieces and nephews, and a legion of dear friends and acquaintances.
