Grant, Sr. 91, of Albany, died Friday at St. Francis Hospital in Columbus, GA.Graveside funeral services will be TUESDAY 11 AM at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. Nancy Scarbrough will officiate.Born at Granite Falls, NC, December 18, 1912, the son of Henry Spivey Grant and Mary Eleanor Price Grant. He grew up in Warrenton, NC, he graduated from John Graham High School and the University of North Carolina , Class of 1937. He was employed by Sears Roebuck immediately upon graduation.Ed retired from Sears in 1976 in retail management after 40 years of service and has lived in Albany since that time. He was a Charter Member of the Dougherty County Kiwanis Club, member of the Albany Chamber of Commerce, and the Radium Springs Country Club. He attended Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church.Ed was a WWII veteran of the US Army, originally drafted for training prior to the war starting. He was called back as a trained reserve when war commenced. He served in the South Pacific, in the Guadalcanal and Soloman Island campaigns. Ed returned to the United States under Army orders with temporary assignments in San Francisco and New Orleans, finishing his duty at Oak Ridge, TN as Deputy Finance and Certification Officer with the Manhattan Project.He is survived by his wife: Josephine Whigham Grant, Albany; a son: Edward (Buzz) Grant, Jr. and his wife Teri, Monroe, GA; a daughter: Mary (Cookie) Grant Hladik and her husband William, Charlotte, NC; 3 grandchildren: Ashley Grant, Zachary Grant, and Jason Hladik.The
