Dr. Edwin Elliot "Chick" Flournoy, Jr. M.D., 87, of Albany died Sunday May 7, 2023, at the Oaks Plantation assisted living in Leesburg, GA.

The funeral service will be held Saturday, 11:00AM July 1, 2023, at Covenant Presbyterian Church. Dr. Biff Coker will be officiating. Interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery,

Edwin E. Flournoy "Chick" was born on November 30, 1935, to Edwin Elliott Flournoy Sr. and Josephine Cotten Flournoy in Jackson, MS. Dr. Flournoy graduated and was a KA from Millsaps with a B.S. Degree then from the University of Mississippi School of Medicine in 1960. He was a captain and flight surgeon in the United States Air Force stationed at Turner AFB in 1961. After his Air Force service in 1965, he opened an office on Slappey for Family Medicine. After the flood of 1994 he was hired to be on the staff of the Phoebe Residency Program. Dr. Flournoy served as President of the GA Academy Family Practice and become a fellow to the American Academy of Family Practice.

After retirement in 2007 he worked in a Locum Tenens capacity with the Veterans Administration and for Dr. Tom Cooper. He was a member of First Baptist Church of Albany and Covenant Presbyterian Church.

He was preceded in death by his wife Mary Elizabeth Flournoy.

Survivors include two daughter, Lynn Flournoy (Shaw) Seely of Jacksonville, FL; Katherine Flournoy (Bob) Lindsey of Albany, GA; four grandchildren Kaitlyn Elizabeth (Thomas) Dubien of Columbia, SC, Kirsten Allyssa Seely of

Jacksonville, FL, Lindsay Nicole Lewis of Cordele, GA, Stevie Leigh Lewis of Albany, GA and a great-grandson, Benjamin Edwin Romeo Dubien of Columbia, SC.
