Eloise Adams Dozier died peacefully in her home, August 31, 2023, after an extended battle with the after-effects of Covid.

Visitation will be at Kimbrell-Stern Saturday, September 2nd at 10:00 a.m. with the funeral service following at 11:00 a.m. A graveside service will follow at the Morgan City Cemetery in Morgan, Georgia. The Reverend Keith Gaines will officiate.

Mrs. Dozier was born in Morgan, Georgia on August 27, 1932, the daughter of the late John B. Adams and Jewell Adams. She graduated from Morgan High School and attended Georgia State College for Women in Milledgeville, Georgia, where she earned her B. S. Degree in Business Education. She later earned her Master's Degree in Business Education from Georgia Southwestern College in Americus. She taught at Morgan High School and at Albany Technical College, where she served as Chairperson of the Business Department for 17 years. She retired after teaching for 32 years. She has resided in Albany since 1953. In early years prior to a full-time teaching career, she was an active member of the Albany Junior Woman's Club and the Albany Junior League. She was a member of First Baptist Church where she was a member of the Adult III Sunday School Class. She sang in the Joyful Saints Choir and was a former member of the Sanctuary Choir. Her interests included golf, bridge, travel, family and friends.

She is preceded in death by her husband and childhood sweetheart of 67 years, Tinsley Beck Dozier, Sr., and her sister, Sue Adams Martin.
