Eloise Griffin Freeman, 72 of Albany, went home to her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on Easter Sunday, April 8, 2007, in the presence of family and friends at her residence. The funeral service will be held at 11 AM Wednesday at Sherwood Baptist Church with Dr. Michael C. Catt, Mr. Ross Powell, and Mrs. Mary Nell Lanier Hall officiating. Interment will follow in Crown Hill Cemetery. A native of Patmos, GA, Mrs. Freeman graduated from Arlington High School. She worked at the Newton courthouse as a file clerk, Ford Motor Contract, Savelle Jewelers, and for the Civil Service at the Marine Corps Logistics Base until her retirement in 1996 after twenty years of service. Mrs. Freeman was a member of Sherwood Baptist Church where she was a member of the Shining Light Sunday School Class, taught the Four Year Old Sunday School Class for thirty-three years, and worked with the Heavenbound Puppeteers. Mrs. Freeman cooked for the Sherwood Christian Academy Eagles at the football and basketball games, for the Wednesday night suppers at the church, and also for the Drey Line. She was a former member of the SCA School Board, and a former member of the Albany Woman's Club. Mrs. Freeman was preceded in death by her husband, Jack Freeman; parents, Charlie and Mary Griffin; and a sister, Christine Griffin Lanier. Mrs. Freeman is survived by a son, Greg Freeman and his wife Sue of Albany; a daughter, Debra F. Strickland and her husband David of Canton; six grandchildren, Lanier Freeman, Kendyll Freeman, Stephen Strickland, Anna Strickland, Lydia Strickland, and Ethan Strickland; two brothers, Charles Griffin and his wife Hortense of Georgetown,
