



Elsa L. Bjorck Obituary

May 4, 1899 - July 3, 2006

Elsa Victoria Lindquist Bjorck, 107, of Albany, died Monday, July 3, 2006 at Magnolia Manor in Americus, GA. Her funeral service will be FRIDAY 10 AM at Kimbrell-Stern with interment to follow at Floral Memory Gardens. Pastors William Diamond and Charles Thompson will officiate. Born on May 4, 1899 in Stockholm, Sweden, Mrs. Bjorck and her husband Carl came to the United States in 1923. She became a US citizen on April 2, 1936, and came to Albany in 1947. Mrs. Bjorck was a member of the Lutheran Church of Our Saviour, where she is remembered for the great care she took of the altar, making some of the altar linens herself. She was supervisor of activities at Blue Springs Plantation, where her husband was the chauffeur for William C. Potter, owner of the plantation. While working at the plantation, which drew its share of dignitaries over the years, she met Presidents Dwight D. Eisenhower and Richard M. Nixon. In 1996, at the age of 97, she made local news as one of the oldest people to register to vote, voting in the presidential election for the first time in 18 years. She was preceded in death by her husband Carl Bjorck, and her parents Carl and Anna Sofia Lindquist. Mr. and Mrs. Bjorck had no children. She met Bill Kueker through the church in the 1950's, and when he began dating his future wife, Sheila, the Bjorck's took a keen interest in them, and they became their "adopted" children. Along with Bill and Sheila Kueker of Albany, other survivors include the Kueker's children and grandchildren: Russell Kueker, Savannah, GA, CW2 Robert Kueker, USA and his wife Holly, in Iraq, stationed at Ft. Campbell, KY, Jon Kueker and Sam
