Emma Bridges Simmons, 101, of Albany, died Sunday, December 4, 2011 in Savannah, GA.

Her funeral service will be Thursday, December 8, 2011 at 12 PM at Kimbrell-Stern with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. The family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern on Thursday prior to the funeral service from 11 AM until the funeral hour. The Rev. Dr. Don Adams will officiate.

Mrs. Simmons was born August 20, 1910 in Turner County, GA. She moved to Albany in 1941. Mrs. Simmons and her husband, Thomas Edward Simmons ran Simmons grocery store on the corner of Madison and Roosevelt Avenue for more than 14 years in the 1940's and 1950's. She managed Albany Homes Apartments for more than 40 years. Mrs. Simmons was a member of First United Methodist Church of Albany for more than 50 years. She was preceded in death by her parents, Andrew Jackson Bridges and Nancy Champion Bridges, Cordele, GA, husband, Thomas Edward Simmons, son, Herbert Simmons, Littleton, CO; 2 sisters, 6 brothers. She loved fishing and cooking.

Mrs. Simmons is survived by her son: William Bridges Simmons and his wife, Janice, Albany; her daughter: Wisteria Simmons Houston and her husband, Warner of Savannah, GA; 12 grandchildren; 23 great-grandchildren; 7 great-
