



## Ethelind Jordan Cannon Obituary

May 31, 1920 - October 12, 2006

Ethelind Jordan Cannon, 86, of Leesburg, died Thursday, October 12, 2006 in Richland at the home of her son Joey. The funeral service will be held at 3 PM Sunday at Leesburg United Methodist Church with Rev. Michael P. Lyons and Rev. Don Adams officiating. Interment will follow in the Leesburg Cemetery. Mrs. Cannon was born in the Philema Community in Lee County to John and Totsy Jordan. She was a member of Leesburg United Methodist Church where she taught the three and four year old Sunday School class for sixty years, and was a member of the Florence Cannon UMW Circle. Mrs. Cannon enjoyed researching geneology and history; loved working with children, and working in her church. She was also a member of Old Herod Chapter of DAR. Mrs. Cannon was a terrific wife, mother, grandmother and friend. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, James M.
