



## Eugene F. Crowe Obituary

June 5, 1937 - September 5, 2003

Born in Mystic, GA, reared in Marshallville, GA, he had lived in Albany for the past 30 years. Mr. Crowe had retired as Claim Superintendent from State Farm Insurance Company after 35 years. During his 35 years in Columbus and Albany he received the Claims Person of the Year in both cities. He was a member of First Baptist Church in Albany and during the past few years Gene and Nancy had become very active with Lake Blackshear Baptist Church in Crisp County as well as First Baptist Church in Albany. Gene was also a member of the Adult 4 Sunday School Class at First Baptist Church and was a former member and past chairman of the Board of Deacons. He had also been a member and past chairman of the Board of Directors of The Anchorage. Mr. Crowe was an active member of the Exchange Club of Albany and was awarded the prestigious honor of being Mr. Exchange in 1988. For the past several years Gene has served as Fair Manager of the Southwest Georgia Fair Association and he was also co-chairman of the UKC Winter Classic which are both sponsored by the Exchange Club of Albany.
