A native of Abbeville, AL, he graduated high school in Pompano Beach, FL as valedictorian of his class. He received his undergraduate degree from the University of Georgia, a law degree from Mercer University, a graduate degree from Georgetown University in Washington, DC, and also received a doctorate degree in American History. Mr. Owens taught in the Dougherty County School System for over 30 years, teaching at Albany High School, and mostly at Westover High School, before retiring in 1996. Survivors include his aunt: Frances Wellman, Albany; friends: Albert Park, Smyrna, GA, Thomas Marshall, Albany, Jo Handley, Albany.
