Eva Phillips Sauls (Mrs. Earl Wade Sauls Sr.) 93 of Albany, Georgia, died June 16, 2012 with her family by her side at the St. Mary's Hospice House in Athens, Ga.

Mrs. Sauls was a native of Cuthbert, Georgia, and moved to Albany, Ga. with her family in 1956.
