



## Mrs. Evelyn Chandler Berg

July 23, 1922 - October 16, 2015

Albany-Mrs. Evelyn Chandler Berg, 93, passed away early Friday morning. Mrs. Berg was a long time resident of Albany.

Mrs. Berg was born July 23, 1922, in Augusta, Georgia, daughter of Brue Stanhope and Elizabeth Wilkerson Chandler and widow of Dr. Joseph L. Berg to whom she was married for 62 years. Mrs. Berg was a graduate of Tubman High School in Augusta, attended the Junior College of Augusta, and graduated from Randolph Macon Women's College at age 19 with a degree in mathematics as a member of Chi Omega Sorority. Evelyn married Lieutenant Berg in 1943, and while her husband served overseas, she worked for US Government during WWII.

Dr. and Mrs. Berg moved to Albany in 1948. Joe began his medical practice and Evelyn worked on multiple fronts caring for a growing family of 3 children, working as a bookkeeper for her husband, and becoming an integral part of the Albany community. Over the years, Mrs. Berg was involved in many church and civic organizations including serving as past president of the Medical Auxiliary, the Hospital League, and the Town and Country Garden Club. Evelyn was active with the Junior League of Albany from its inception, the First United Methodist Church, the Albany Jr. College Museum, and the National Society Colonial Dames of America.

Evelyn is pre-deceased by her oldest daughter, Elizabeth Berg Barry (Don, deceased) and her grandsons, Paul and Hank Davis. She is survived by her daughter, Susan Berg Frenzel (Jim) of Sandy Springs, and her son, Dr.

Joseph Chandler Berg (Karen) of Albany, grandsons Charles Joseph Frenzel (Chika) and Patrick Chandler Berg, both of Atlanta, granddaughters, Lindsay Berg Evans (Ross) of San Antonio, Texas, and Lara Berg Vicars (Adam) of Atlanta. She is also survived by 2 great grandchildren, Misuzu Caroline Frenzel and Chandler Gilman Vicars.
