Evelyn Benson Russell, 87, of Albany, died Friday, February 4, 2007 at Lee County Health Care. A native of Cedartown, GA, she had lived in Albany since 1953. Mrs. Russell was charter member of Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church, a member of the Fellowship Sunday School Class where she served as a teacher and as a president of the class. She was a member of the Commodore Richard Dale Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution, serving as a Past Regent and as a delegate to the national convention.
