



Evonne S. Mull

September 15, 1946 - November 24, 2025

Howelyne Evonne Mull, 79, passed away November 24, 2025. She died peacefully at home surrounded by her family. She had been under hospice care for several weeks due to a long illness.

Evonne was born on September 15, 1946, in Columbus, Georgia, at Fort Benning. She grew up in Lee County and graduated from Lee County High school in 1964. Shortly after, she married James “Smokey” Mull in 1965. Evonne started her career in the Dougherty County Clerk’s office in 1966 and was deputy Clerk from 1988-2000. She was elected Superior Court Clerk in 2000 and served 6 terms before retiring December 31, 2024. Evonne should be remembered for her dedication and faithful service to her community for 58 years.

Evonne is preceded in death by her husband James Arnold Mull. She is survived by her two daughters, Kelli Evonne Tennison (Kathryn Anne Tennison, Brice Tennison) and Staci Anne Neal (Katie Neal, Russell Neal), her brother Scott “Bubba” Smith and her sister Kim Kraft. She had one great grandchild, Kimani Fisher (Kathryn Tennison). Evonne had many nieces and nephews.

The family will receive guests on Saturday December 6, from 12:30-2:30 at Kimbrell Stern,

followed by a private graveside ceremony for family.
