Frances Cherry Bishop, 86, of Albany passed away on Sunday, May 13, 2018 at home surrounded by her family after a lengthy battle with kidney disease. Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, May 15 at 3:00 at Kimbrell-Stern with Rev. Wesley Kaylor officiating. Interment will follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. Visitation is Monday, May 14 from 5:00 to 7:00 at Kimbrell-Stern.

Mrs. Bishop was born in Stewart County on February 1, 1932 where she graduated from Stewart County High School. After completing an associate's degree from Georgia Southwestern College and an undergraduate degree in education from Georgia Southern, she taught school for a number of years. In her second career, she obtained a dental hygiene degree from Albany Junior College and worked as a hygienist until she was 83.

Mrs. Bishop was a loyal member of the Thronateeska Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution, the United Daughters of the Confederacy, and the Colonial Dames. She attended Sherwood Baptist Church. She loved to go attend plays, speech contests, and patriotic events. She was a prolific cake baker, especially for birthdays and holidays.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Joe Brannan Cherry and Effie

Singleton Cherry; her brothers, Joe Cherry, Jr. (Amelia) and Leonard Guy Cherry; her niece, Rachel Cherry Simmons, and her grand-nephew Michael Singleton.

Her family was her pride and joy.
