ALBANY – Frances Sterne Weintraub, 89, of Albany, died Sept. 14, 2017 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital.

A funeral service will be held Sunday, September 17, 2017 at 3 PM at Kimbrell-Stern. Visitation will be held one hour before the service at Kimbrell-Stern. Interment will follow at Oakview Cemetery.

Mrs. Weintraub was born Jan. 24, 1928 to the late Lee Sterne and Carolyn Gershon Sterne in Albany. She was married to the late Joseph Weintraub for 59 years.

A graduate of Albany High School, Mrs. Weintraub attended Sophie Newcomb College of Tulane University in New Orleans. She was secretary and co-owner of the Sterne Company, an Albany food brokerage firm. Mrs.

Weintraub, a devoted wife, mother, mother-in-law, sister, grandmother and friend, was a past member of the Board of Trustees of Temple B'Nai Israel and was the congregation's first female president. She was a member of the Silver Sneakers exercise group, first at Gold's Gym and then at the Albany YMCA. Mrs. Weintraub, known as "Miss Frances" became the official volunteer greeter – receiving her own nametag at the Y – and attended classes there five days a week until the time of her death. She was also an avid fan of crossword puzzles and entertainment news, a devotee of card games, a wonderful cook and baker and the family historian.

Survivors include three children, her daughter Carolyn Maschke and her husband David of Albany; son Glenn Weintraub and his wife Jodi of Atlanta; and son Neal Weintraub and wife Mary Jane of Augusta, four grandchildren; Ariel Maschke of Udaipur, India; Frances Larson of Atlanta; and Sylvia Weintraub of Lubbock, Texas, and Daniel Weintraub, of Augusta; two sisters, Pauline Schochet of Gainesville, FL and Carla Linn and her husband, Steve, of Wellington, FL; and two brothers, Lee Sterne of El Paso, Texas and George Sterne and his wife, Sylvia, of Seattle, WA and New Orleans, LA, and numerous nieces, nephews, cousins and brother- and sister-in-laws.
