Mr. Frank F. Faulk, Jr., 90, of Albany, died Thursday, November 23, 2017 at Wynfield Park.

A funeral service will be held Saturday, November 25, 2017 at 11 AM graveside at Crown Hill Cemetery.

Mr. Faulk was born in Albany, GA on August 16, 1927 to Frank and Annie Laurie Faulk. He graduated from Albany High School in 1944 and went on to graduate from The University of Georgia in 1950 with a law degree. He began his law career in Albany, GA in 1950 with W. Delacy Allen and opened his own practice in 1955, where he worked until retiring in 1994. He was an avid outdoorsman, a member of First Methodist Church Albany, GA, a brother of Sigma Alpha Epsilon, and Phi Delta Phi (Scholastic).

He was preceded in death by his wife, Betty Ann Faulk.
