



Frank Cochran Vann, Sr. Obituary

July 21, 1928 - April 30, 2007

Mr. Frank Cochran Vann Sr., 78, died Monday April 30, 2007. at his residence. The memorial service will be held at 11:00AM on Thursday, May 3, 2007, at Camilla United Methodist Church. Rev. Richard Trawick officiating. Mr. Vann received his Bachelor of Arts Degree from the Virginia Military Intstitute. He began law school at the University of Florida, then transferred to the University of Georgia School of Law where he earned his Doctorate of Jurisprudence Degree. Upon finishing law school, he returned to Camilla to open his law practice. Approximately two years later, he attended Judge Advocates General training at the University of Virginia and thereafter served honorably in the Korean War. Upon returning from Korea, Mr. Vann reopened his law practice in Camilla. At the time of his death, Mr. Vann had been practicing law for 56 years. In addition to practicing law, Mr. Vann farmed for many years, including partnering with his son Scott for over 20 years. Mr. Vann was active in his community and State. Positions held included District Governor of the Lions Club, President of the Mitchell County Bar Association, Founding Chair of the International Section of the State Bar of Georgia, and Executive Secretary of the Mitchell County Democratic Party. Mr. Vann also served one term as Georgia State Senator for the 10th District of Georgia, where received the honor of Most Outstanding Freshman Senator. Mr. Vann was a member of Camilla Methodist Church, where he taught Sunday School for many years. He was an avid orchid grower and gardener. Mr. Vann is survived by his wife, Janie Cagle Vann, with whom her recently celebrated 50

years of marriage; two sons, Frank Cochran Vann, Jr. of Camilla, Georgia, and Scott Emory Vann and his wife Staci of Baconton, Georgia; two daughters, Elizabeth Janie Vann of El Paso, Texas, and Mary Georgia Vann Hamilton and her husband George, of Atlanta, Georgia; Three grandchildren, Mary Georgia Hamilton, Frank Emory Vann, and Robby Jane Vann; and numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins. The family will be at the Vann home at 227 Main Street, Camilla, Georgia. The family would prefer that instead of flowers, donations be made to the donor's favorite charity.
