



Fred R. Dusterdieck Obituary

May 24, 1952 - June 4, 2003

Fred was born in Cincinnati, Ohio on May 24, 1952. He moved to Albany as a child and lived here most of his life. Fred was a devoted Christian husband and father. After graduation from Hamilton High School in Hamilton, Ohio, he joined the Navy during the Vietnam War. Being an avid sportsman, Fred was an active member in the exclusive FPB hunting club in Ellaville, GA. He coached Dixie League Baseball in Albany for several years going on to coach fast pitch softball in West Chester, Ohio. Fred was a lifelong member of First Presbyterian Church where he was an ordained Elder, Sunday School Superintendent, and Moderator of the Outreach Committee and sang in the Chancel Choir. He also served the Flint River Presbytery through the Celebration of Faith Committee. Mr. Dusterdieck worked as an electrician with Proctor and Gamble for 25 years. He was preceded in death by his father, Fred Walter Dusterdieck.
