



## Mr. Fred Freeney, Sr. Obituary

Mr. Fred Freeney, Sr., died Sunday, July 22, 2012 at Wynfield Park Nursing and Rehabilitation.

His funeral service will be Tuesday 11 AM at Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church with interment in Crown Hill Cemetery. Rev. Leigh Ann Raynor and Rev. William Collins will officiate. The family will receive friends Monday 6 to 8 PM at Kimbrell-Stern.

A native of Macon, Mr. Freeney had lived in Albany since 1962 and was employed as a pharmaceutical representative for many years, after which he worked in petroleum sales. He graduated from Lanier High School where he was in the ROTC and was also a graduate of Mercer University. He was a member of Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church the Key Sunday School Class, American Legion and the Elks Lodge.

Mr. Freeney was active with SOWEGA Council on Aging performing numerous logistical tasks as well as their Meals on Wheels program. He trained for chronic disease self-management with the SOWEGA Council on Aging.
