Fred Loney Tolbert, Jr., 89, of Albany, Georgia passed away February 25, 2019 at University Hospital in Augusta, Georgia.

A native of Albany, GA, Fred was the son of the late Fred Loney Tolbert and Irene Dekle. He was a graduate of Albany High School. After graduation, he was proud to serve his country in the United States Army, stationed in Hawaii and Alaska.

Following his military service, he returned to Albany where he worked at Albany First Federal Savings & Loan, serving as President for many years. Following his time with the bank, Fred was a member of the Board of Directors for Blue Cross Blue Shield of Georgia. He was a long time member and served a term as President of the Albany Rotary Club. Fred served on the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta - Bank Financial Institutions Advisory Committee. In addition, he was proud to serve his community through involvement in multiple organizations, serving as President of the Georgia League of Savings Associations, the Albany Chamber of Commerce, the Dougherty Civitan Club, United Way of Dougherty County, Society of Real Estate Appraisers, and as Trustee to the Darton College Foundation.

He is survived by his wife of 52 years, Ann Jackson Tolbert; sons: Fred Tolbert Finney (Debbie) and Randall Jackson Tolbert (Gail); daughters: Angela
