



## G. Douglas Collins, Jr. Obituary

November 23, 1906 - February 26, 2003

A native of Mitchell County, Mr. Collins grew up in the Flint Community. He graduated from the University of Georgia in 1929 and received a Masters Degree from the University of Tennessee in 1932. For over thirty years, he worked as an agricultural statistician for the Crop Reporting Bureau, U.S. Department of Agriculture, working in North Carolina, Washington D.C. and Tennessee. After his retirement, he returned to Camilla in 1964 with his wife and daughters. He was a member of First Baptist Church Camilla. Along with managing his tree farm, Mr. Collins served as the church treasure for 23 years, served as a deacon and was a member of the Fellowship Sunday School Class. He was preceded in death by his wife, Hazel Rebecca Swearingen who died in February 1999, his parents, George Douglas Collins, Sr. and Addie Lee Martin Collins, a sister, Laurie Marion Collins and two brothers, Julian Walden Collins and William Martin Collins.
