G. Lawson Vann, 79, of Leesburg, GA passed away Sunday, February 5, 2017 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital. Funeral services will be held Friday, February 10 at 10:30 a.m. at Covenant Presbyterian Church in Albany. Dr. William Coker will officiate. Interment will follow in Leesburg Cemetery.

Born in Quitman, GA he was a graduate of Albany High School and Georgia Tech where he was a member of the Alpha Tau Omega fraternity. He served in the U.S. Army and retired from the Marine Corps Logistic Base in 2004.

He was an active member of Covenant Presbyterian Church where he sang in the choir and served as an elder. He was a former deacon of the First Baptist Church in Albany.

Previously he served on the Lee County Planning Commission, the Tax Assessors Board of Lee County, and the Board of the Southwest Georgia Chapter of the American Red Cross.

He was preceded in death by his father Charles Louis Vann and his mother Eugenia Garrett Vann of Albany.
