



## Mr. George N. Bundrick

George Nathan Bundrick, 89, died Thursday, January 25, 2018 at Willson Hospice House.

His funeral service will be at 12:00 PM, Wednesday, January 31, 2018 at the graveside at Ebenezer Baptist Church Cemetery in Crisp County. Mr. Bill Cox will officiate. The family will receive friends at Klmbrell-Stern prior to the service on Wednesday from 10:00-11:00 AM.

Mr. Bundrick was born in Warwick, GA, and was a Navy veteran of World War II. He was a machinist by trade and retired from Civil Service at MCLB in the Repair Division.
