Geraldine "Gerrie" Ann Mantooth died Saturday, February 23, 2008 at her home in Albany. The funeral service will be held at 11 AM Saturday, March 1, 2008 in the chapel at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. Billy Hannah will officiate. Entombment will follow in Crown Hill Mausoleum. Mrs. Mantooth was born on September 28, 1942 in Washington, DC to Glen E. Loflin and Dorothy Moffitt Loflin. She attended schools in Fairfax, VA and then business school in DC. She was preceded in death by her parents and her husband and love of her life, Marine SGT. Major Donald W. Mantooth. They married on February 14, 1964. During their years in Albany, they owned Williard's and the Half Time Oyster Bar. Gerrie worked at Kaiser Agricultural Chemicals, Dougherty County Juvenile Court and at the time of her passing, was still employed as Principal Court Clerk, Clerk of Courts, Dougherty County Board of Commissioners. Mrs. Mantooth is survived by her sister, Nan Mason Higgins and her husband Terrence of Chicago, IL, as well as her "children" Miss Prissy and Miss Charo. Her love of animals was legendary in Westwood. Her pockets were always filled with treats. She wishes her memory to be honored by holding close the ones you love, telling them often that you love them, being kind to all of God's creatures and to be there to lift others up when their wings can no longer fly.
