Mrs. Rockett was born in Americus, GA, on May 12, 1916, the daughter of the late W.T. and Alma Findley Collins, both natives of Cherokee County, GA. She had lived for the past 48 years in Albany, where she taught sixth grade at Sherwood Elementary School. During the last part of her 23 year career, she served as the math supervisor for the Dougherty County School System. She earned her Bachelor's degree from The Women's College of Georgia in Milledgeville and was a member of the Delta Kappa Gamma Honor Society for Women Teachers. She was a member of First Baptist Church of Albany. Her husband, Grady L. "Pete" Rockett in 1969 and her brother, J.A. Collins of Americus, also preceded her in death.
