Harold B. Smith, Jr., 82, died Friday, February 23, 2018 at Willson Hospice House. Graveside services will be held Tuesday, February 27, 2018 at 12:00 PM at Andersonville National Cemetery in Andersonville, GA. Rev. Debbie Cone will officiate.

Born in Venton, Maryland, Harold served his country in the US Air Force. He was a former CEO for Flint Electric, was a member of Post Legion 30 and Avalon United Methodist Church. Harold was a Godly man, serving as a lay pastor for Weona United Methodist Church as well as devoting his time to jail ministries.
