VON SCHLICHTEN – Harold Carl, 100, of Albany died April 12. Born August 22, 1918 and raised in Cincinnati, Ohio, son of Otto and Anna (Erlwein) Von Schlichten. Preceded in death by parents, sons Carl “Ebo” and Paul “Pablo,” infant daughter Anna Maria and sister Margaret Myers. Survived by loving wife of 70 years Ligia (Isaza), son Richard married to Karen Esaias, Johnstown, PA, daughter Cristina, Panama City, FL, grandchildren Jessica, Jennifer and John Paul and great granddaughters Marlee and Sylvia. Harold received B.A. and M.A. degrees in Geology from the University of Cincinnati. He entered military service shortly after U.S. entry into World War II. He retired as a Major after 20 years of honorable service in the U.S. Army and later U.S. Air Force, serving primarily as a cartographic officer including wartime service in Africa, the Middle East, India and Korea with peacetime service in Chile, Costa Rica, Colombia, Japan and British Guiana.

Subsequently, he worked in Civil Service at Turner AFB and the Marine Corps Logistics Base in Albany. He retired in 1985 after 22 years of service. He was a member of Air Force Photomapping Association, Albany Community Chorus and Mended Hearts. He has been a resident of Albany for the past 60 years. Family and friends will be received from 4-7PM with a wake service at 6:30PM on Sunday, April 14 at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors. Funeral mass will be celebrated at 11:00AM on Monday, April 15 at St Teresa's Catholic Church.
