



## Mrs. Harriet Ingram Godbee

August 24, 1922 - January 17, 2015

Mrs. Harriet Ingram Godbee, 92, of Albany died Saturday January 17, 2015 at Winfield Park Health and Rehabilitation.

The funeral service will be held at 2:00 PM on Tuesday January 20, 2015 at Sherwood Baptist Church with interment to follow in the Crown Hill Cemetery.

Mrs. Godbee was born on August 24, 1922 in Hagerstown, MD. to the late James P. and Grace Fink Harter. She was an RN and delivered babies in Hagerstown during WWII while all the Doctors were serving overseas. After the war Mrs. Godbee moved to South Georgia where she continued her nursing by traveling around Dougherty County giving immunization shots to all the people who lived in the rural areas. Mrs. Godbee retired as a Nursing Supervisor from the Dougherty County Health Department after many years of service.

Mrs. Godbee enjoyed traveling, riding bikes, working in her yard and spending time at her mountain cabin. She was a member of Sherwood Baptist Church, the Vota Vita and Friendship Sunday School Classes.

Survivors include her daughter, Mary Anderson of Leesburg; son, Jim Ingram (Elizabeth Strater) of Greensboro, NC; grandchild, Ami Ingram-Fillippa (Dominic) of Houston, TX; brother, James P. "Jim" Harter III of Morgantown, WV; great grandchildren, Nic Fillippa and Lillian Fillippa, and a number of nieces and nephews.

In addition to her parents Mrs. Godbee was preceded in death by her husbands, Rev. Mercer Byrd Ingram and Mr. Rayford L. Godbee, Jr.
