Harry Perry Andros, 81, of Albany, died Thursday, March 1, 2007 in Atlanta, GA, following an illness. His funeral service will be MONDAY 2 PM at St. Paul's Episcopal Church with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. Father Alex Chetsas will officiate. A native of Voutiro, Greece, Mr. Andros had lived in Albany since 1952. He was a well respected member of the Albany community and former partner/owner of the Quickie Restaurant.
